Independent Women's Voice strongly applauds the introduction of the Student Empowerment Act by Senator Ted Cruz. Independent Women fights for women and their loved ones by effectively expanding support for policy solutions that aren't just well-intended, but actually enhance people's freedom, opportunities, and well-being.

The Student Empowerment Act delivers flexibility and opportunity to American students by amending the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow 529 savings accounts to be used for educational expenses for all K-12 students, including public, private, and homeschooled students.
